Steve Arnold, a Republican, is serving his fourth term on the Guilford County Board of Commissioners. He was first elected to represent District 2 in 1990 and most recently re-elected in 2006. He served as the Board of Commissioners' Chairman in 1990 and Vice Chairman in 1991 and 2006.
