Bruce Davis is serving his third full term on the Guilford County Board of Commissioners. He was elected in April of 2002 by precinct vote to fulfill the unexpired term of the Honorable Donnie Dunovant. He was elected to a four-year term in November 2002 reelected in 2006 and in 2010. He served as Chairman of the Guilford County Board of Commissioners in 2005.



He is a native of High Point where he attended High Point Central High School. Upon graduating from HPC he enlisted in the United States Marine Corps and served from 1975 to 1995. He has served in numerous assignments from east to west coast. As an Aviation Equipment Mechanic at The Naval Air Station Dallas Texas and later as a Career Recruiter in Oklahoma City, his service would cause him to serve one tour in the Far East to include; Japan, Philippines, and Korea.
