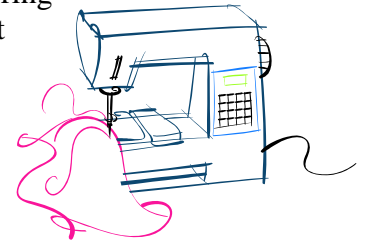
### Gizmos & Gadgets... Who Done It?

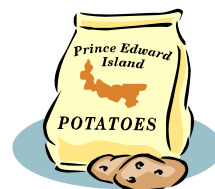
### Sew Much More!
