OCTOBER 11, 2011 MUNICIPAL PRIMARY ELECTION

Now through Tuesday, October 4 - 1 Week Prior:

Letters of request from any qualified voter may be received now through October 4 - G.S. 163-230.1 (a) and 163-302(a)

Now through Monday, October 10 - 1 Day Prior:

Letters of request from any voter with a sickness or a disability may be received now through October 10 - G.S. 163-230.1 (a) and (a1)

Sunday, September 11 - 30 Days Prior:

If changes in time or additional meetings are to be held, a schedule shall be published in a newspaper circulated in the county and a notice shall be posted at the courthouse door. Similar notice shall be given of the dates and hours of the weekly meetings. G.S. 163-230.1 (c1)

Sunday, September 11 - 30 Days Prior:

Date absentee ballots are required to be available. G.S. 163-302 (b)

Saturday, August 27:

Ad containing election information additionally for letters of request, applications and One-Stop (In Person) Absentee Voting (3 times before registration deadline)

Friday, September 16 - 25 Days Prior:

Registration deadline G.S 163-82.6 (c)

No Excuse One-Stop Absentee Voting:

One-Stop (In-Person) absentee voting in GB and HP offices.

Please see schedule - G.S. 163-227.2 (b)

One-Stop (In-Person) same day registration ó G.S. 163-82.6A (a)

Tuesday, September 27 - 2 Weeks Prior:

Last day to adopt resolution to begin counting ballots between the hours of 2 pm and 5 pm on Election Day. A copy shall be published once a week prior to the election. G.S. 163-234 (2)

Registration Deadline: Friday, September 16

1. In-Person Early Voting Period:

In-Person Early Voting in GB and HP Offices

2. Written requests for By-Mail Ballots may be received from now through Tues., Oct. 4

a. By-Mail Absentee Ballots may also be requested with a handwritten letter by the voter or near relative which needs to contain the following information:

1. Date of Election.
2. If registered as unaffiliated, may declare preference for any party's ballot. If no preference indicated, will receive an unaffiliated ballot. (Primary only)
3. Voter's Name Printed - Name Should Match Voter Registration
4. Voter's Current Legal Residence Address in Guilford County - Should Match Registration
5. Address to which Voter's Ballot Is to Be Mailed
6. Voter's Date of Birth
7. Daytime Phone Number and/or email address (optional, but helps election official contact voter in the event of a problem with the request)
8. Signature of Voter, Near Relative or Verifiable Legal Guardian ó Request Cannot Be Honored Without Signature! ***Power of Attorney's signature is not acceptable unless a near relative.***
9. If Near Relative Signs Request, also Print Name and Address of Near Relative or Verifiable Legal Guardian
10. Also state relationship to voter: Spouse, brother, sister, parent, grandparent, child, grandchild, mother-in-law, father-in-law, daughter-in-law, son-in-law, stepparent, stepchild or verifiable legal guardian. ***(Power of Attorney is not acceptable as a near relative unless one of the above.)***
