

For Voting Precinct, US Congressional District, NC Senate District, NC House of Representatives District, County Commissioner District, Board of Education District, and Superior Court District:

Go to http://gcgis.co.guilford.nc.us/guilford_new/

Read the statement in the message box that appears and click 'OK'.

In the upper right corner of the screen, click 'Parcel Search'.

In the 'Parcel Address:' field, enter the property address, then click 'Search'. If no parcels are found:

- 1) Enter a nearby address that can be found after searching, or
- 2) Enter either the house/business/apartment building number or the street name and see if the property is listed in the available choices after searching.

Once a property is found, click the + to the left of the property owner and address information, then click 'Zoom To Parcel' in the View field.

Once the property is displayed, click 'Layers' in the upper right corner of the screen. Voting district information is located in the 'Elected Representation' folder. To see a district, check the box to the left of the district layer, then click 'Refresh Map' located at the top of the list. The district boundary and number will display on the map.

If you are unable to see the district number, turn off layers in other folders by unchecking the box to the left of the layer name and clicking 'Refresh Map'.

If you want to zoom in, zoom out, pan around the map, or determine the address of a property on the map, use the tools located along the top of the map display area.

For Greensboro City Council Districts:

Read the statement in the message box that appears and click 'OK'.

In the upper right corner of the screen, click 'Find Address'.

The rest of the steps are the same as above. Council districts are under the 'Administrative' folder.

For High Point City Council Districts (Wards):

Go to http://pdweb.high-point.net/website/chp_map/

Click the mailbox icon (Find Address) in the toolbar above the map display area.

The rest of the steps are the same as above. Council districts (wards) are under the 'Voting' folder.
