

Food Safety Training in Spanish

Foodborne illness can cost your restaurant an estimated \$75,000 or more. Foodborne illness is nearly 100% preventable *if* safe food handling practices are applied.

Two native Spanish-speakers will teach this three-day food safety training entirely in Spanish. Vicky Montenegro and Maria Welsh, both natives of Colombia, are microbiologists and registered ServSafe™ instructors.

This three-day training is designed for managers and supervisors of foodservice operations. The course is not intended for individuals who do not have any supervisory responsibilities. The topics that will be covered include:

- basic microbiology
- good hygiene practices
- safe food handling practices
- pest control
- facility and equipment requirements
- cleaning and sanitizing.

Attendance is mandatory for all three days of training. All participants who successfully pass the certification exam with a 75% or higher will earn two-points credit on their quarterly inspection report. The registration fee is \$150.00. The fee includes one training manual and one certification exam. The attached registration form must be completed and returned at least one week before the first day of the class. Registration fees must be paid by check. The check must be made out to: **North Carolina State University**.
